PREREQUISITE(S)/COREQUISITE: 18 years of age, student must bring a mechanically sound ATV and proper PPE (DOT approved helmet, full length pants, shirt or jacket with full-length sleeves, steel toe boots that cover the ankle, eye protection, and gloves that cover the full hand and fingertips).

REQUIRED TEXT/RESOURCE MATERIALS: Provided

CALENDAR DESCRIPTION: Whether an all-terrain vehicle (a four wheeled machine that is straddled such as a quad) is used in an industrial (workplace) environment or for recreational purposes, safe-riding practices should be followed.

The ATV Rider Training course is a nationally recognized and developed by the Canada Safety Council and Alberta Safety Council for the benefit of both industrial and recreational ATV operators.

Completion of this course has become mandatory in many major companies for employees and sub-contracted personnel who use an ATV on the job site.
