Course Description: This course will cover the major developments in painting and sculpture which occurred during the final decades of the nineteenth century and the early twentieth century. The development of modernism will be considered within the context of the changing social, political and philosophical ideas of the time.

Lectures will follow approximately the same order as the text book, however emphasis will vary and additional material will be presented in class.
