Calendar Description: This course provides a continuation of AR 3410

integrating drawing with individual/studio interests.

Course Content: AR 3410 will explore the use of monochromatic and

color media in drawing. Various methods of representing space and describing the human form will be explored. Development of a personal style will be encouraged.

Objectives:

1. Learn the basic principles of two-dimensional design: line, shape, value, texture, color, tone and

composition.

2. Manipulate the elements of visual art on a twodimensional surface through the application of depth of depth perception (overlapping, mechanical perspective, diminishing size and detail, tonal modeling).

- 3. Perceive visual relationships in the environment and record these perceptions in terms of the elements of visual arts.
- 4. Exhibit a basic working knowledge of the fundamental techniques and materials of drawing including the use of pencil, conte, charcoal, pen and ink, brush, watercolor, colored pencils and collage.
- 5. Development the basic skills to render and record the human form.
- 1. The level of creativity and craftsmanship demonstrated.

- **Criteria for Evaluation:** 2. The degree of knowledge and understanding of the elements and principles of this particular studio discipline.
 - 3. Portfolio presentations will be required throughout the duration of this course.
 - 4. Professional orientation as indicated by enthusiasm, commitment, involvement and flexibility in collective and individual critiques.

Mid-term: 45%: Drawings completed by March 3, 2004. 45%: Drawings completed by April 14, 2004. Final: Involvement: 10% Grade based on participation, and class attendance.

Assessment and Grading:

No late assignments will be accepted unless accompanied by a doctor's note. Late assignments will receive lose 10 % grade for each day late.
