**REQUIRED TEXT/RESOURCE MATERIALS: Halo** 

**CALENDAR DESCRIPTION:** DR 1200 is a production-based class where learning is centered on acting in a major production. Enrollment is through auditions to be held during the last week of November 2011. Students must pre-register with the instructor for their audition time. Students who are cast in the play will receive course credit for their work if they enroll in DR1200 or DR2200.

CREDIT/CONTACT HOURS: 6(0-0-6) 90 hours compressed to 11 weeks

**DELIVERY MODE(S): Laboratory** 

**OBJECTIVES (OPTIONAL):** The course content is the learning, rehearsing, and presenting of the chosen play in 10 public performances. The play to be produced during the 2012/13 Winter session is *Halo* by Josh MacDonald. The performance dates are March 7 to 16, 2012. The course is an 11 week intensive, requiring some rehearsal hours in December and 10 to 15 hours per week of class/rehearsal time, expecting the Production Weeks (March 4 to 16) to be the most intensive weeks with both daytime and evening rehearsals and performances. There will not be formal rehearsals during Reading Week but students are

encouraged to hold their own practice sessions. The last class will be March 22 as a final debrief and wrap up class.
