**I. Course Description**

This course provides private study of one's principal instrument..

**II. Prerequisite**

Consent of the Department is needed. This course is restricted to full-time students only.

**III. Corequisite**

Performance in an ensemble is required of all students taking an applied study.

**IV. The Course in Perspective**

This course is the first year of applied instruction on an brass instrument being the student's major instrument. It is a single-term course offered over the full year. This course is recommended for Applied Music Majors but is available to B.Ed. students majoring in secondary music education. The course consists of one hour of private instruction and a master class each week.

**V. Assignments**

Studies and pieces will be assigned by the instructor. Students will be expected to have practiced the assigned material. If a student is unprepared for the lesson, the instructor may dismiss the student from the lesson.

**VI. Grading**

Students will be required to take a jury at the end of the first term, and then at the end of the year. A grade will be assigned by the applied instructor in consultation with the jury.

**VII. Materials Needed**

Students are required to provide their own instruments. Some instruments are available to rent through the Fine Arts Department. Students will be required to purchase their own method books and performance pieces.
